PixArt filed a complaint against Avago Technologies General IP (Singapore) Pte. Ltd., Inc., Avago Technologies ECBU IP (Singapore) Pte. Ltd., Inc, and Avago Technologies USA, Inc. for a declaratory judgment

On February 8, 2010 (California Time), PixArt Imaging Inc. (“PixArt”) has filed a complaint against Avago Technologies General IP (Singapore) Pte. Ltd., Inc., Avago Technologies ECBU IP (Singapore) Pte. Ltd., Inc, and Avago Technologies USA, Inc. (collectively “Avago”) for a declaratory judgment, alleging our developing product –sensor for using in pseudo optical trackball (“Product”), is within the scope of Patent License Agreement executed dated July 13, 2006 between Avago and PixArt. Due to several indications and evidences, PixArt has reasons to believe that pseudo optical trackball is a type of optical mouse/trackball, and it is PixArt’s intention to continue paying royalties pursuant to aforementioned Patent License Agreement for sales of its Product.

Since the Product is still under development, we believe that there shall be no substantial impact on our business as well as our financial status.
